

Keystage 1 to Keystage 2 Analysis – Year 7 – 2016

In the Summer of 2016 pupils in Year 6 sat new scaled score tests at the end of Key Stage 2.

Students were given a predicted Key Stage 2 score for the Reading, Writing and Maths tests based on their prior attainment at Key Stage 1.

The table above shows students scores and where you can see a blue cell, this highlights a negative score between the students predicted Key Stage 1 score and what they actually achieved at Key Stage 2.

For example, Courtney has a Key Stage 2 reading score of 76 and a predicted reading score of 93.82 which makes her 17.82 below her prediction.

- 75% of our Year 7 students were below their predictions in Reading.
- 90% of our Year 7 students were below their predictions in Writing.
- 77% of our Year 7 students were below their predictions in Maths.

Furthermore when compared to national data:

- 8% of our students made expected progress in Reading compared to 66% nationally.
- 0% of of our students made expected progress in Writing compared to 74% nationally.

- 8% of of our students made expected progress in Maths compared to 70% nationally.
